WHO we are:

Pediatric Interim Care Center, The Newborn Nursery, is the first program in the nation providing 24-hour transitional care for drug-exposed and medically fragile newborns. PICC is a qualified nonprofit for tax purposes. Our Tax ID is 91-1485176.

WHAT we do:

PICC brings babies safely through recovery from the effects of prenatal drug exposures, including fentanyl and other opiates, methamphetamine, cocaine, and prescription drugs. The pioneering program also supports visitation for families, provides caregiver training, follows the babies after they leave, and offers a range of community outreach and education services.

WHERE we are:

The center is located in Kent, Washington, 20 miles southeast of Seattle.
